HOW TO OBTAIN A KNOX BOX

- Visit www.knoxbox.com
- In the top left corner, select your local fire department agency
- Set your location as **Pennsylvania** and type **Rostraver** in the search box

Rostraver Township and its fire departments operate a Knox Box program to protect properties from damage during fire and medical emergencies

BACKGROUND

Ordinance 751, adopted September 7, 2022, amended Township Code Chapter 93 (Fire Prevention) to require certain properties to install a Knox Box secure key box to provide immediate emergency access to firefighters leading to increasing efficiency; preventing costly forced entry damage and allowing undamaged doors to be re-secured after the emergency; and protecting property, inventory, equipment and supplies as well as firefighters against possible injury. Fire department vehicles are equipped with a electronic secured vault which holds the master key, and provides an audit trail for all key usage.

The Knox Box system is UL-listed and used by over 8,500 jurisdictions nationwide.



WHO **CAN** INSTALL A KNOX BOX?

ANY commercial or residential property

WHO **MUST** INSTALL A KNOX BOX?

- **All existing commercial buildings equipped with automatic fire detection and/or suppression systems**
- All multi-family residential buildings that have restricted access through locked doors and have a common corridor for access to the living units
- All existing commercial buildings constructing improvements that require Planning Agency approval
- All new commercial buildings
- All new single-family buildings with sprinkler systems
- Any locked gates or driveways which allow access to a commercial business
